



The GLC provides a homecooked meal prepared by the Fellowship Committee twice a month for the Hammond City Rescue Mission.


Meals include; entrée, sides, beverage and dessert.

GLC Social Media Updates

The social media team is aware of recent issues concerning our Facebook livestreams and Youtube video postings. They are working hard to remedy these issues in a timely manner. A few updates include:

Current Facebook livestream connection and buffering issues should be fixed within a week with the help of a new software update.

Copyright and licensing issues have been resolved and meet the updated criteria so future services uploaded to Youtube should remain available to viewers indefinitely. Previous videos that have been taken down are currently being reviewed but there is no certainty they will be reinstated.

Facebook will soon no longer keep livestreams in archive for more than 30 days. If anyone wants a copy of a service, please let Deanna know as soon as possible and she will download a file for you. Services will also remain available on Youtube for viewing.
